Education Grant: We received final approval and on September 16th Jim Hunt from the District Grant Committee will present the grant check to the club. We will then in turn present a check to IGH Community Schools and Intermediate School District No. 917. This grant will be purchasing an Otoacoustic Emissions (OAE) hearing screening device to be used by the local school districts (#199, #197, #6 and #917) for screening preschool children with hearing problems. OAE screening is considered to be the most objective, physiologic screening tool available to identify young children with permanent, sensorineural hearing loss as well as a wide range of other hearing health needs. It will be used to screen over 100 children a year. A special thanks to the WSP Rotary Club for its financial contribution to the project also.

Fill The Throne!
